Q. This was your first clay court match of the season. How was it for you?

DANIELA HANTUCHOVA: Yeah. Jesus, it's been such a long time since I've been here, and we love it. Yesterday we walked around the city a little bit, a little bit of shopping. And there's so many great galleries, and walking by the river was just so beautiful and the restaurants are great. So yeah, I can't believe it took me so long to come back.
