JOHN BERKOK: Questions for Shuai Peng.

Q. You fought so hard to get back to 3-3 in the second set. What do you think happened after that?

SHUAI PENG: Well, I think today she played good, and in the first set my serve I hit more harder than the second set. And yeah, I think today was like her serve is better than me, yeah.

Q. You looked like you had a little twinge in your foot or your leg. Were you moving as well as you wanted to?

SHUAI PENG: No. My knee is not -- like right side it's not that good and it start from like a couple months ago in Indian Wells, I started bad hurt, but I play a lot of matches, and now I feel like not really -- like how do you say? I feel more pain.

Q. I know you're disappointed today, but how about the week for you? Are you happy with how you're playing in general?

SHUAI PENG: Yeah. I'm happy. I think today she played good, and then I think I'm a little bit tired and from long tournament. I tried to like move her around and could not get it, but I tried to hit, but I think it still is not like 100 percent fast. But I tried my best today, and she played good. And I

am happy to win to the semi final and then keep going, yeah.

Q. After you're done here, are you going to have a couple of days to relax and recuperate?

SHUAI PENG: Yes, but I still have to play doubles, and then after this I go back to home. I think I have like three, four days off and then I'm like practice like two weeks and then go to Madrid.

Q. How are you going to relax?

SHUAI PENG: Sleeping. No. I think I will like go like out with friend dinner, shopping, watch movie and then do what all the girls do, I guess.
